This QQI Training, Delivery and Evaluation Level 6 course is for anyone who wishes to learn or improve training techniques and increase confidence in their training ability while gaining a recognised academic qualification.

The course will equip those who are considering training as a career option with the skills, knowledge and confidence to effectively, design, develop, deliver and evaluate training programmes. You will learn new skills and ideas through both theoretical and practical means.

Upon successful completion of the course participants will be equipped with the knowledge, skills and competence to develop an intervention to meet the needs of particular groups of people. The Participants will receive a QQI Level 6 award which is a recognised training qualification but also by national agencies such as the Education Training Boards (ETB's).
