The Building Futures programme is a QQI accredited programme with participants working towards a QQI Level 5 major award in Community Development. The training is delivered in our Learning Hub which is located at 88-90 Townsend Street, Dublin 2. CDET B training allowance (including transport, meals and childcare) are available to participants while on Building Futures.

In addition to the major award there is the opportunity to undertake training in areas such as addiction studies, child protection, suicide prevention, supporting survivors of violence, Anti-Trafficking, manual handling, fire safety warden and first aid responder.
